LEUKOCYTE ALKALINE PHOSPHATASE (LAP) TEST

Effective Date: March 1, 2016

Effective March 1, 2016, the Leukocyte Alkaline Phosphatase (LAP) test will no longer be performed at Beaumont Health – Royal Oak or Troy.

The LAP is a non-specific test and is not recommended for evaluation of myeloproliferative neoplasms. Thus, a BCR/ABL is suggested to evaluate for Chronic Myelogenous Leukemia (CML). If Polycythemia Vera or other myeloproliferative neoplasms are a consideration, then JAK2 V617 testing would be suggested.
