Helicobacter pylori Testing Update

Effective Date: January 3, 2017

Effective January 3, 2017, Beaumont Laboratory will no longer offer *Helicobacter pylori* **IgG** testing. Both the American Gastroenterological Association and American College of Gastroenterology consider the test to be of limited clinical utility as highlighted below:

- Poor positive predictive value for active *H. pylori* infection. Therefore, a positive result cannot be used to accurately predict the presence of active disease
- *H. pylori* IgG does not differentiate past from current infection.

However, Beaumont Laboratory offers 2 non-invasive diagnostic assays for *H. pylori* infection:

1. H. pylori Breath Test

Patient is asked to ingest a solution containing ¹³C-labeled urea. ¹³C is a non-radioactive isotope of carbon. If *H. pylori* urease is present in the stomach, the ¹³C-labeled urea will be degraded into ammonia and labeled carbon dioxide (¹³CO₂). The latter breakdown product is exhaled through normal respiration and collected in a specialized bag for subsequent testing. The value is compared to a breath sample collected prior to ingestion of the labeled urea. A positive result is indicative of an active *H. pylori* infection. 2. H. pylori Stool Antigen Test

Test detects *H. pylori* antigen in fecal specimens released from organisms lining the stomach wall. A positive result is indicative of an active *H. pylori* infection.
