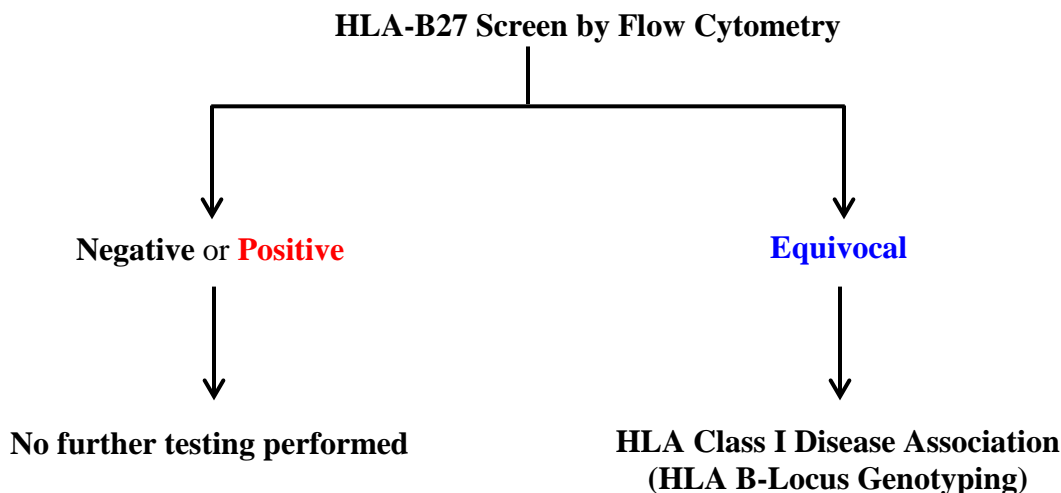


Reflex Test for Equivocal HLA-B27 Screen by Flow Cytometry

Effective Date: January 30, 2017

The HLA-B27 screening test performed by flow cytometry is reported as positive or negative. If the result is equivocal by flow cytometry, the HLA Laboratory performs supplementary testing and genotypes the HLA-B locus by PCR to determine the presence or absence of B27. Currently, those results are incorporated into the flow cytometry report. Effective January 30th, the HLA genotyping supplementary test will be formally ordered as “Class I Typing for Disease Association”, and a separate report will be issued.
