

### Beaumont Laboratory Policy: Once per Lifetime Laboratory Tests

**Effective Date: October 16, 2017**

#### Policy

The Beaumont Laboratory Test Utilization Committee has identified specific tests that should only be performed once during a patient's lifetime. If EPIC identifies a result for these tests within the Lab Results section of the patient chart, then a repeat order will not be permitted.

This policy has been approved by all Beaumont Health Medical Executive Committees of all 8 sites.

If you feel that it is necessary to have a test repeated, please call your request into your site's Laboratory to speak to a Pathologist.

The following tests will no longer be available to order more than once in EPIC:

- Platelet Glycoprotein Polymorphism Antigen Analysis
- Angiotensinogen (AGT) Genotyping
- Angiotensin II Type 1 Receptor (AT1R) Genotyping
- Angiotensin Converting Enzyme (ACE) Genotyping
- Factor V Leiden (FV) Genotyping
- Prothrombin (PT) Genotyping
- Hyperhomocysteinemia (MTHFR) Genotyping
- Hereditary Hemochromatosis (HH) Genotyping
- Apolipoprotein E (ApoE) Genotyping
- Cystic Fibrosis Mutation Analysis (Carrier Screening)
- Newborn Blood Karyotype
- Y Chromosome Microdeletion Molecular Analysis for Male Infertility
- HLA B27 Screen
- HLA B57 Screen for Abacavir Sensitivity
- Plavix/Clopidogrel Genotyping (CYP 2C19)
- CYP2C9 - VKORC1 Genotype (Warfarin Sensitivity Genotyping)
- Fragile X Syndrome
- Prader-Willi/Angelman Syndrome
- UGT1A1 Genotyping for Gilbert/Irinotecan
