

Updated Point of Care Glucose Critical Values

Effective Date: January 14,2020

The point of care glucose critical values were flagging at >300 for all age groups at the Farmington Hills campus. This was not in alignment with the other Beaumont sites, and we are modifying this to be standardized with the rest of the system. Below are tables of the previous (incorrect) critical values and the corrected critical values with corresponding age groups.

	>17 Years	<50 and >300 mg/dL

	24 Months – 16 Years	<50 and >300 mg/dL
	>17 Years	<50 and >500 mg/dL
