Beaumont Laboratory COVID-19 Test Reporting to MDHHS: New Requirements

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The U.S. government passed Public Law 116-136, § 18115(a), also known as the CARES Act which requires laboratories that perform testing to detect SARS-CoV-2 to report results from each patient test to the Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS). HHS has set forth required data elements to be reported with the laboratory test results.

Effective Date: August 1, 2020

As mandated by the HHS; Beaumont Laboratory will facilitate the provision of the required information to our local public health departments by supplying your offices with the cards pictured below which must be returned to Beaumont Laboratory with every specimen for COVID-19 testing. This card does not act as a laboratory order and will not replace a valid script or requisition orders for laboratory testing. Offices utilizing Epic EMR will enter the required patient information into Epic upon order placement and hence, are not required to complete the card below.
