

UPDATE TO SOURCE EXPOSURE TESTING

Effective Date: July 12, 2022

On July 12, 2022 there will be additional questions required when ordering the HIV 1/2/ Hepatitis Source Panel (LAB6648). They have been added to be able to link any source patient testing to the employee that has had the exposure. The new screen is pictured below:

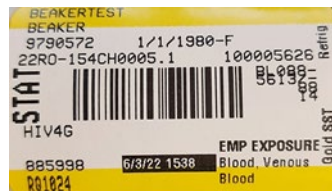
