## **Blood Gas Panels Update**

Effective Date: 11 June 2024

Effective June 11th, total carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>) values will no longer be reported on the blood gas panels.

This change will avoid redundancy as bicarbonate (HCO<sub>3</sub>-) values are also reported on these panels. The total CO<sub>2</sub> content includes the bicarbonate as well as available forms of carbon dioxide (*i.e.*, dissolved CO<sub>2</sub> and carbonic acid). Generally, the bicarbonate comprises about 95% of the total CO<sub>2</sub> content. Both total CO<sub>2</sub> and bicarbonate values are excellent estimator of each other.
