Thank you for your inquiry about the Corewell Health School of Medical Laboratory Science program!

This program is designed for interested post-baccalaureate candidates - non-MLS degree and MLS degree alike. Enthusiastic, self-directed students do very well in our program lecture series (weeks 1-25; full-time online & in-person) and clinical laboratory rotations (weeks 26-46; clinical sites full-time M-F). Upon successful completion of the program, graduates can receive a promising offer of employment under our tuition-free 2-year service commitment. Students who successfully complete the program are eligible to apply for the Medical Laboratory Scientist certification exam offered by the American Society for Clinical Pathology Board of Certification and seek employment in numerous clinical laboratory disciplines.

## ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS:

- U.S. equivalent of B.S. degree
- Major in Biology, Microbiology, Chemistry, Biochemistry, Molecular, Medical Laboratory Science
- GPA of 2.7 or higher both overall and science courses to be verified by submitting official transcript(s) from all universities attended.
- Completion of the following baccalaureate-level courses within the last 7 years and before the program start date: INTRODUCTION TO CLINICAL LABORATORY SCIENCE – proof of enrollment required at interview. 1
  - a. In-person college course. Note: This is preferred for higher admission ranking and program success.

    - a. GENERAL MICROBIOLOGY with laboratory
    - b. Alternate: An online Microbiology course per the attached Alternate Courses document.
  - 4. **MATH** (intermediate algebra or higher)
  - PHYSIOLOGY (required) / ANATOMY (preferred) 5.
    - a. Alternate: An online Human Anatomy & Physiology course per the attached Alternate Courses document.
  - **STATISTICS** (preferred) 6.
- Additional skills: Microsoft Office Word, PowerPoint, Excel plus Internet/email applications
- Permanent U.S. resident or authorization to work in the U.S. Michigan residents are given 1<sup>st</sup> priority.
- Previous work experience (required) with good letters of recommendation from faculty (1-2) and employer (1-2).
- Approval of the MLS Admission Committee to ensure GPA and university coursework meet both program admission requirements and certification agency requirements.
